Requirements	· Minimum 1 year of full-time study at home university(BS)
	$\cdot$ GPA (Grade Point Average) of 3.0 or better (on a 4.5 Point scale) or equivalent GPA
	<ul> <li>English Language Proficiency level in accordance with GIST requirement when English is not the first language</li> <li>(TOEFL IBT 80 or TOEIC 750 or other equivalent English language proficiency test score)</li> </ul>
	* It would be waived for the students from English medium institutions.
	<ul> <li>* If the student does not have the score of English language proficiency level, the certificate issued by home university's language center is possible.</li> <li>The Certificate or letter should be submitted during the application process</li> </ul>
	$\cdot$ The student will study at GIST for a semester and pay tuition fees to their home university.
	* If GIST agrees, the student can study for up to two semesters. (may changes due to the Covid-19 situation)

	Dormitories are <b>free</b> for all exchange students. (Bedding rental is USD \$20 per month/ optional)	
	• The room is for 2 people, furnished with beds, closets, desks, and chairs. (blankets and pillows are not included) Shared facilities include restrooms, showers, study rooms, washing machines, clothes dryer, and a lobby.	
Dormitory	· All types of heaters and cooking equipment are not allowed.	
	<ul> <li>* A housing deposit of 140,000 KRW incurs when checking-in</li> <li>To receive a deposit, Korean bank account is needed (Refund will be transfered within 2-3 working day after pass the room inspection)</li> <li>* Room inspection</li> <li>Period: Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday during the final exam week</li> <li>Application: via Google form from the GIST college House Dormitory student council</li> </ul>

VISA	$\cdot$ All applicants who are not Korean need a visa to study in Korea. In order to get a visa, you must apply for one with the original certificate of admission issued by GIST at the embassy or consulate of the Republic of Korea in your home country.
	* The certificate of admission will be sent to the student on early June 2023.(via mail)
Health Insurance	• GIST does <b>not</b> provide any insurance for exchange students. Also Korean National Health Insurance is mandatory for the international students who are staying 90days or above(\$50/month). There are few exceptions in countries. All incoming exchange students must acquire health insurance that covers them during the full duration of their stay overseas either private or KNHI. Details will be announced to the applicants.
Alien Registration	$^{\cdot}$ As an international student, it is essential to issue an Alien Registration Card(ARC) to stay in Korea for more than 90 days.
Arrival Dates / Orientation	<ul> <li>The Student should arrive before two weeks prior to the beginning of the semester.</li> <li>Individual orientation by GIST International advisor will be proceeded.</li> <li>GIST offers Korean Language courses.</li> </ul>
Bank	• To create a bank account, it is needed to issue an Alien Registration Card(ARC). Usually, it takes 2 months after your arrival in Korea.
