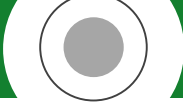

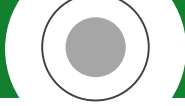

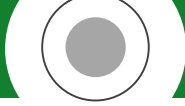
Informacje ogólne

Co to jest COST?

Europejski Program Współpracy w Dziedzinie Badań Naukowo-Technicznych (*European Cooperation in Science and Technology*), znany pod akronimem COST, to utrzymywana wspólnie, obecnie przez 36 państw europejskich i Izrael (jako państwo współpracujące), struktura instytucjonalna, której najważniejszym zadaniem jest organizowanie multilateralnej współpracy naukowo-technicznej krajów członkowskich.

Powstała w 1971 r. inicjatywa ma na celu organizowanie i koordynację pojedynczych projektów prowadzonych w różnych krajach, a mających wspólny cel ogólny.

Zaletą programu COST jest możliwość inicjowania projektów przez samych naukowców, a następnie włączanie w nie osób z zainteresowanych krajów (*bottom-up*)



Informacje ogólne

- międzyrządowa sieć europejskiej współpracy w dziedzinie nauki i techniki, która wspiera koordynacje badań finansowanych przez poszczególne kraje (PL: projekty międzynarodowe niewspółfinansowane, NCN: „Harmonia”),
- finansuje spotkania, wizyty, organizacje konferencji, lecz nie finansuje badań,
- oferuje naukowcom z Europy platformę współpracy i wymiany doświadczeń w określonym projekcie,
- projekty te nazywane są akcjami,
- akcje trwają cztery lata

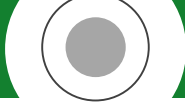

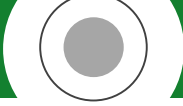

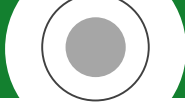
Informacje ogólne

- W ramach programu przyznawane są środki finansowe na koordynację badań w ramach tzw. akcji (rocznie ok. 130 tys. euro na akcję tj. na pokrycie kosztów przejazdów i uczestnictwa w spotkaniach roboczych i sympozjach), obejmujących określony temat badawczy realizowany w różnych krajach,
- Akcję koordynuje Komitet Zarządzający – MC (*Management Committee*), składający się z reprezentantów (do dwóch) spośród krajów zainteresowanych daną problematyką badawczą. Członkowie MC – spotykają się 2-3 razy do roku w celu koordynacji badań i organizacji otwartych sympozjów,
- W ramach akcji tworzone są Grupy Robocze
- Dokumentem określającym główne założenia akcji jest *Memorandum of Understanding*



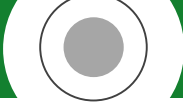

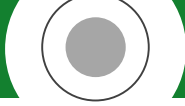
Short Term Scientific Mission – Krótkookresowe misje badawcze

- przeznaczony dla młodych naukowców, w tym dla doktorantów;
- *Early Career Investigators* (ECI) - an individual who is within a time span of up to 8 years from the date they obtained their PhD/doctorate (full-time equivalent);
- krótkookresowe wizyty w instytucjach biorących udział w danej akcji;
- okres pobytu: min. 5 dni, max. 90 dni;
- dofinansowanie 2 500 EUR na cały okres pobytu (refundacja kosztów);
- po powrocie należy złożyć raport z pobytu



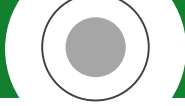

COST Actions

COST Actions are a flexible, fast, effective and efficient networking instrument for researchers, engineers and scholars to cooperate and coordinate nationally funded research activities. COST Actions allow European researchers to jointly develop their own ideas in any science and technology field.

COST Actions are bottom-up science and technology networks, open to researchers and stakeholders with a duration of four years. They are active through a range of [networking tools](#), such as workshops, conferences, training schools, short-term scientific missions (STSMs), and dissemination activities. COST does not fund research itself.

COST prides in its support for high-risk, innovative and emerging research themes. However, COST does not set any research priorities.

COST Actions can also pave the way to or establish synergies with [EU-funded research projects](#). Moreover, collaboration within research projects can also lead to new Actions, thus enhancing the networking potential of such consortia.

COST Actions cover scientific and technological research activities for peaceful purposes and of public interest, aiming to contribute to the [COST Mission](#).

Every COST Action has an objective, defined goals and clear deliverables. These are described in a Memorandum of Understanding, accepted by at least seven participating COST Member States.

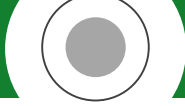

Cancer nanomedicine - from the bench to the bedside

Finding efficient cancer therapies is an urgent and still unresolved problem and, in the fight against this disease, scientists are devoting tremendous efforts towards the utilization of nanomedicines. Nanotherapeutics exhibit major benefits with respect to unmodified drugs, including improved half-life, more efficient tumour targeting, and reduced side effects. However, only a few nanotherapeutics have reached the commercial level, most still being in the investigational phase. Accordingly, this Action aims at developing and strengthening industry-academia relations with an ultimate goal: fostering the clinical translation of nanomedicine from bench to bedside. This will be achieved by creating the first, pan-European interdisciplinary network of representatives from academic institutions and small and medium enterprises including clinical research organizations (CROs) devoted to the development of nanosystems carrying anticancer drugs from their initial design, pre-clinical testing of efficacy, pharmacokinetics and toxicity to the preparation of detailed protocols needed for the first phase of their clinical studies. By promoting scientific exchanges, technological implementation and innovative solutions, the Action will provide a timely instrument to rationalize and focus research efforts at the EU level in dealing with the grand challenge of nanomedicine translation in cancer, one of the major and societal-burdening human pathologies. By virtue of its quality, the Action network will also generate research core teams of excellence for funding applications, patent filling and discovery of major scientific impact. The network will also be actively devoted to raising awareness on the high potential on nanomedicine through publications in international peer-reviewed journals, and presentations at open events.
