◆ **Recipients' Benefits:**

- Monthly stipend of NT\$25,000 for a maximum of 10 months.
- Free Chinese courses for 2 hours per week.
- Reserve on-campus housing space.

◆ **Recipients' Responsibilities:**

- Take Chinese courses at least for 2 hours per week
- Take “Exploring Tainan Course” (or “Global Immersion Course”)
- Assist and deepen interactions by completing at least 1 mission*.
(Eg. Assist info session of student exchange programs, promotion video, hosting international visitors, etc.)
- Enhance English-Speaking environment in NCKU by completing at least 1 mission*.
(Eg. teaching assistant for the course of “Exploring Tainan”, English Empowerment and Community Service, NCKU campus news anchor/reporter, etc.)
- Share and Feedback: Share your stories as being NCKU International Ambassador by any form of media.

◆ **Eligibilities:** NCKU exchange and degree students from European universities and with European nationality.

- Attend OIA's briefing session for international students.
- Take 0.5 or 1 day field trip organized by the CLC.

Future Degree-Seeking Students

◆ *Recipients' Benefits:*

- Monthly stipend of NT\$20,000, granted for a maximum of 6 months.
- Airline tickets provided (up to NT\$ 30,000) while achieving academic score of 85 points or above in the 1st Chinese language program.

◆ *Recipients' Responsibilities:*

- Complete 2 continuous seasons of NCKU Chinese language program
- Participate in lectures, cultural excursions, international exchange activities, etc.
- Apply for a NCKU master's or doctoral program for the upcoming fall/spring academic semester

◆ *Eligibilities:*

- Currently enrolled in an European university;
- Senior-level undergraduate or second-year graduate student with enough required credits to graduate from their home university.
- Scholarship recipients must apply to their degree program at NCKU before finishing the Chinese Language program.
