



Ordinance No. 35
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences
of 4 May 2026
on admission limits to the SGGW Doctoral School in the 2026/2027 academic year

Pursuant to sections 7-9 of the SGGW Doctoral School Admission Rules as outlined in Appendix No. 1 to Resolution No. 50 - 2025/2026 of the Senate of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences of 26 January 2026 on the SGGW Doctoral School admission rules for doctoral students beginning their studies in the 2026/2027 academic year at the Doctoral School of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences, it is hereby ordered as follows:

§1

The number of available places at the SGGW Doctoral School for the 2026/2027 academic year shall be:

- 1) in the field of agricultural sciences:
 - a) in the discipline of forestry - 6 places;
 - b) in the discipline of agriculture and horticulture - 5 places;
 - c) in the discipline of food technology and nutrition - 11 places;
 - d) in the discipline of animal science and fisheries - 4 places;
- 2) in the field of veterinary science in the discipline of veterinary - 8 places;
- 3) in the field of engineering and technology:
 - a) in the disciplines of civil engineering, geodesy and transport – 3 places;
 - b) in the discipline of mechanical engineering – 2 places;
 - c) in the disciplines of environmental engineering, mining and energy – 5 places;
 - d) in the discipline of information and communication technology – 2 places;
- 4) in the field of social sciences:
 - a) in the discipline of economics and finance – 5 places;
 - b) in the discipline of sociology – 1 place;
 - c) in the discipline of management and quality studies – 1 place;

- d) in the discipline of educational studies – 1 place;
- 5) in the field of natural sciences in the discipline of biological sciences – 5 places.

§2

The number of places referred to in § 1 does not include places allocated to candidates under the “Industrial Doctoral Programme”.

§3

In justified cases, SGGW reserves the right to accept a smaller or larger number than the limit in § 1.

§4

The implementation of the ordinance is entrusted to the SGGW Doctoral School Director.

§5

The supervision of the execution of the ordinance is entrusted to the Vice-rector for Science.

§6

The ordinance shall enter into force on the date of signature.
