



Ordinance No. 29
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences
dated 20 April 2026

on fees for educational services charged to students commencing their studies in the
2026/2027 academic year

Pursuant to Article 23(1) in conjunction with Article 79(1) and (2), Article 80(1) and (2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1571, as amended) and section 6(2) of the Study Regulations at the Warsaw University of Life Sciences introduced by Resolution No. 76-2018/2019 of the Senate of the SGGW of 26 April 2019 on the adoption of the SGGW Study Regulations (as amended), the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 27 September 2018 on studies (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 2787), Ordinance No. 28 of the Rector of SGGW of 20 April 2026 on the introduction of rules for calculating the costs of education and determining the amount of fees for educational services charged to students commencing their studies from the 2026/2027 academic year, and Ordinance No. 19 of the Rector of SGGW of 23 April 2024 on detailed rules for the collection of fees for educational services in first- and second-cycle programmes and uniform master's programmes from the 2024/2025 academic year, other fees related to the pursuit of these studies, and the procedure and conditions for exemption from these fees in whole or in part (as amended), it is hereby ordered, as follows:

§ 1

1. The amount of fees for educational services charged to students of first-cycle, second-cycle, and integrated master's degree programmes commencing their studies in the 2026/2027 academic year (study cycle) is set at the amount specified in the annex hereto.
2. The fees referred to in section 1 shall apply for the planned duration of the course of study, expressed in terms, subject to sections 3 and 4.
3. In the event of repeating a term or academic year, resuming studies, returning from leave of absence, or a student's return following a disciplinary penalty of suspension of certain



student rights, the student shall pay fees at the rate applicable to students of the year group to which they are joining.

4. Until the completion of studies by persons admitted in the 2026/2027 academic year, the University may not introduce new fees for them. It may increase the fees referred to in section 1 only once per academic year and by no more than the total consumer price index for the previous calendar year, as announced by the President of Statistics Poland pursuant to Article 94(1)(1)(a) of the Act of 17 December 1998 on pensions from the Social Insurance Fund (Journal of Laws of 2025, item 1749), by a total of no more than 30% of the amount of those fees. This does not apply to increases in fees for courses not covered by the study programme, or to increases in fees for the use of student dorms and canteens.

§ 2

The implementation of this ordinance is entrusted to the deans of the faculties.

§ 3

Supervision of the implementation of this ordinance is entrusted to the Vice-Rector for Didactics.

§ 4

This ordinance shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
